Mission:

BisMarket provides access to a variety of locally grown, high quality, farm-fresh products direct from local producers. This family-friendly market enhances community building, fosters local business development and encourages healthy food choices in a green outdoor space.

History/Background:

BisMarket was established in 2013 and born of Go! Bismarck Mandan (a community-based health coalition) aiming to increase access to local foods so as to enhance health indicators for the community (fruit/vegetable consumption).

Locations have included Sertoma Park (2013 - 2015), Good Shepherd Lutheran Church (weekday evening 2015 - 2016), BisMan Food Co-op (weekday evening 2017, 2018), Kiwanis Park (2016 - current).
