Cottage Food and Ready-to Eat Vendors: In the interest of good self-governance, BisMarket requires all Cottage Foods and Ready-to-Eat vendors to attend a food safety training (inspected food trucks and restaurant vendors are exempt). We believe this proactive decision will lend a sense of legitimacy to the producers and the market as it relates to cottage foods. Online and in-person training is available. See the following online course options and a link to cottage food information from the North Dakota Department of Health.

Some food safety training programs list “valid through” dates on certificates of training; please complete training on or before this date if listed on a food safety training certificate.
